Happy New Year!

Dear All.

Welcome back to a new term and a new year. Let us hope that 2022 is a healthier year for us all. I hope that you all managed to have some kind of break over Christmas and that your plans were not disrupted too much. We are looking forward to a new term with new topics and plenty of exciting learning activities. There are trips planned across the school and we hope that these will not be disrupted by any changes to COVID guidance. There have been a couple of updates to guidance over the holidays so please do read below as a reminder.

COVID UPDATES

 Face coverings to be worn on site until further notice. We hope that this will not be for too long.

From the 11th January there are changes regarding the need for PCR tests.

- If you have NO symptoms but test positive on a lateral flow devise then you no longer need to book a PCR test to confirm the result. You will need to notify the relevant authority and isolate for 10 days unless you test negative on day 6 and 7 on a lateral flow device and then you may come out of isolation. If day 6 remains positive then you need to test day 7 and 8. In order to come out of isolation you need to have a negative result for two consecutive days or reach day 10 when you are automatically released from isolation.
- Please note that if you have symptoms then you are still required to have a confirmation PCR test.
- Please continue to notify school of all positive results as we are required to submit these to Oxfordshire County Council.
- If a member of your household tests positive then pupils will need to LFT test daily to ensure there is no spread to the school environment.
- As there is no longer a staggered start to the day, please ensure that younger siblings are picked up before walking around to KS2.

Starting Primary School

Primary school places – Reminder - if your child was born on or between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018, you need to apply for a primary school place IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY DONE SO. You must still apply even if your child already attends a nursery attached to the school. Deadline for applications is 15 January 2022.



Please have a look at the notice boards around school – we are currently one of the beneficiaries of the Tesco community token scheme. If you do shop at Tesco, then please do collect the tokens and pop them into the Longfields School collecting tube. All monies awarded through the scheme will go towards improving the KS1 playground area.

Attendance and Lateness

This may be strange to talk about attendance when there has been so much absence due to COVID, but it is something that as a school we monitor on a regular basis.

As we enter term 3 we will be looking a little closer at absence patterns. We will obviously take in to account any absences due to COVID, but this attendance analysis will highlight those children whose attendance is low or whose lateness is high. Please note that school starts at 8:55a.m and that we no longer operate a staggered start to the day. As attendance was highlighted as an issue for some groups of children during our last Ofsted inspection, we are expected, more so than normal, to ensure this issue is addressed.

Please do not be offended if you are contacted in regards to your child's attendance. This may happen if your child's attendance is below 90% without good reason. In some instances where improvement in attendance is not noted, attendance contracts may need to be agreed with support from the County Attendance Team if needed.

Please help us to ensure all our children are in school as often as they possibly can be.
