How it works:

The school offers wrap around care from 8:00a.m. until the start of the school day and then After School care from 3:20 pm until 5:00p.m. or 6:00p.m.

We are able to offer places for up to 40 children at both Breakfast and After School Care.

You simply need to ensure you have filled out the relevant booking forms and drop off your child. They will get a healthy breakfast and/or tea, and play with our wide range of activities in the safety of their school environment.

The children are encouraged to give their club an identity by helping to choose equipment and resources throughout the year and are able to display their artwork and crafts within 'the cabin'. We provide a range of opportunities for the children that are appropriate for their ages with the chance to relax and unwind within an environment that mirrors our school values and caring ethos.

Those attending the club will still be able to access other teacher led after school clubs and will be taken over to the Cabin when they have finished.

Healthy Options:



The children are provided with a healthy choice of cereals, fruit and toast for breakfast. Tea is also a healthy light meal, either hot or cold. The children are consulted when devising menus and getting their help to make the food is an occasional activity.
