# **School Office Enquiries**

- All enquiries to the office should be made by email or phone call

# **Equipment**

#### **PE Kits**

• PE kits should not be brought into school. Your teacher will let you know what day they are doing PE and your child should come to school in their PE kit for the day.

#### **Plimsolls**

Plimsolls will be needed for inside classrooms and the school building

### **Book Bags**

- Book bags can be brought to school and they will be stored in the pupils own drawer for the day.
- Only bring into school what is necessary no additional luggage

#### **Lunch boxes**

- Lunch boxes should be brought in as normal.
- All children will be eating packed lunches, ether from home or supplied through Fresh Start

#### Water Bottles

• A named water bottle **MUST** be brought into school each day

### **Pencil Cases and equipment**

 Pupils do not need to bring in their own pens etc – each child is provided with their own equipment by the school and this is kept in their drawer for their use only

# Equipment and personal belongings from last year

 All belongings left in the cloakrooms or pupil drawers last year has been moved on to the pupils' new classroom – to be taken home or put in their new drawer.

### **Swimming**

 There will be no swimming until at least January as the pool is closed for maintenance

### **Coughs and Colds**

- We are moving into Autumn and Winter and pupils will get colds and coughs
- If they just have the 'sniffles' they should come to school as usual
- Any worries about illness (in regards to COVID 19) should follow guidelines in terms of self-isolation and testing

#### **School Meals**

- School meals **MUST** be ordered in good time.
- Fresh Start will no longer be able to provide a lunch at short notice
- If a lunch is not ordered or forgotten then one will need to be brought to school by a family member or friend
- Please make sure you order a week in advance

#### **Woodlands and Everdon**

- Government Guidance has not changed in regards to residential trips
- Woodlands is now planned for February
- Everdon is now planned for May
- This will be reviewed in line with Government Guidance
