<p>Microsoft Teams <i>Listens to stories with increasing recall.</i></p>	<p>10am - Meeting with your Teacher on Microsoft Teams. Practising Phase 2 and 3 tricky words using flashcards. Show literacy activity for the day.</p>
<p>Phonics</p>	<p>Write 3-5 sentences using tricky words we looked at in our session. Read the sentences to someone in your family. Do they make sense? How many tricky words have you used?</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Visit https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/on-the-move-week-1/ Watch Session 5 - Making bridges. Complete the activity attached.</p>
<p>Literacy/Topic</p>	<p>Have a go at the Seaside writing sheet we looked at this morning. Can you write some sentences about the pictures you see? Try to add some describing words to your sentence to make it really interesting. Record yourself reading the sentences you have written and send them to us.</p>
<p>Reading</p>	<p>Log in to your bug club account and read an allocated book. Remember to complete the quiz.</p>
<p>Microsoft Teams</p>	<p>2:00pm - End of the day meeting on Microsoft Teams One More/One Less bingo. Before the session choose 3 numbers between 1 and 10 and write them down. 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Additional Activities:

The following Activities can also be done daily if and when you have time.

Sentence writing - write a sentence about something you have done each or choose an object from the house to write a sentence about. Remember capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and that it makes sense. Try to make your sentence interesting using some describing words.

Write a short story - can you write a short story? Choose a character, a setting, a magic object. We would love to hear some of your stories.

Letter formation - practice your letter formation making sure you start the letter at the correct place. Try to keep your letters neat and all the same size.

Tricky words - Have a go at practicing writing your tricky words and see if you get them right. See if you can write each tricky word into a sentence.
