We are going to recap c and k. Get an adult to write these words out on pieces of paper: <i>cat, kit, kid, can, cot, cod, cap</i> . Encourage the child to join in saying the sounds with you and see if they can call out what word is being made. Repeat a few times until the children read the CVC word.	Can you sound out and write these sentences? The cot is red.

Then click play and read the words as the trucks come onto the screen.</p>	<p>Write these tricky words on pieces of paper: to, no, go I, the, into</p> <p>Get an adult to hide them around the house and go on a tricky word hunt.</p>	<p>Write the sentence: I can go into the cot.</p> <p>Remember to count how many words there are in the sentence. Also remember to have a capital letter at the start, finger spaces and full stop at the end.</p>
